Now available to hire from Europcar locations across the UK, the addition of the Kia Niro EV gives drivers the valuable opportunity to put electric vehicle usership to the test.

Long-term rental also makes sense for businesses as they transition to zero emissions. We are thrilled to have the Kia Niro EV on the Europcar fleet – a compact SUV that is a great solution for town and city driving and gives customers even more choice."

The multi-award-winning Kia Niro EV boasts a range of up to 285 miles and a 72kW charging speed that can take it from 10–80% charge in 45 minutes.ⁱ As a practical and comfortable ride, it gives the customer a real word taste of EV driving.

The addition of the Kia Niro EV complements Europcar's stress-free approach to vehicle charging for its rental fleet, to ensure customers do not have to worry about returning the
